Power to Decide Applauds Reintroduction of the Abortion Care Awareness Act

(WASHINGTON, D.C.) — Yesterday, Representatives Jasmine Crockett (D-TX) and Dan Goldman (D-NY) announced the introduction of the Abortion Care Awareness Act. The bill would require the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) to run a coordinated national public health education, awareness and outreach campaign to provide accurate information regarding where and how to access abortion care.

In response, Power to Decide CEO and practicing OB-GYN, <u>Dr. Raegan McDonald-Mosley</u>, released the following statement:

"Power to Decide applauds the introduction of the Abortion Care Awareness Act. At a time when mis- and disinformation about sexual and reproductive health care is rampant, this legislation is necessary to increase access to abortion care information and resources for all who need it.

"As an OB-GYN who includes abortion care as part of my practice, I've seen countless patients struggle to reach me due to the spread of mis- and disinformation. For many, the inability to access information about what services are available, what resources they can seek and what legalities they may have to encounter push abortion care completely out of reach.

"That's why Power to Decide created AbortionFinder.org, the most comprehensive directory of trusted and verified abortion service providers and assistance resources in the United States. Everyone deserves the right to access the health care services of their choosing, but that right means nothing without trustworthy information and equitable access. I applaud the Abortion Care Awareness Act and urge members of Congress to support this important legislation."
